Allan King and the Production Crew of "Who Has Seen the Wind", the feature length film to be made in Saskatchewan this summer, will be conducting a series of workshops in film-making while staying in the Province. The workshops will include instruction and practical experience either as crew members or observers. The sessions will be up to 8 weeks in duration. There will be no registration fee. Successful applicants will be responsible for their own transportation and accommodation. Preference will be given to applicants with film-making experience. If justified by demand, a series of seminars will be conducted in late 1976 by workshop participants to pass along knowledge acquired to other members of the film community as well as those interested in exploring film-making as a career.
